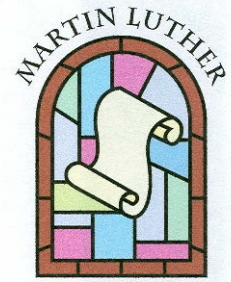

DEVOTION

Dear Fellow Christians !

"Christ our life, you are alive to offer re-creation" – I remember this Easter praise when I look at the picture in the middle. This picture – together with many more – was a big help when I worked in the East African steppe among the Maasai. Sister Katharina Kraus painted these pictures. She was a veterinarian in a Catholic clinic and since she loved painting used this for the Gospel.

Here we see a Maasai woman, in her ordinary blue garment, being surprised by an appearance of Christ. Here I think of Mary Magdalene who is so sad while she walks to the tomb, in her hand the container with the spices, and then discovers that Jesus is alive!

In the middle of her daily life, this Maasai woman is touched by Jesus' word. In her hand, she holds a kibuyu, a traditional gourd, usually filled with milk or water. It symbolizes the pains of the daily life, the daily tasks and difficulties. But Mary encounters the Risen Christ, and this renews her life. The colours indicate this already: her garment is dark-blue, her head is

surrounded by the gloomy purple of Lent. But the Risen Christ radiates in bright white and gold.

"Mary!" – in the moment when Jesus addresses her so individually, she recognizes him. "Master!" – her answer expresses all the happiness of this surprising discovery. Jesus is not dead, no, he is risen, her master is alive! "Go to my brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'" These are only a few words of her Master, but they will change everything.



The woman who had just to obey and work in the traditional African society, she now has been sent to share the Good News with the men. She will be a teacher and preacher for the whole community. I felt privileged to witness this change in the Maasai

society, women receiving a new dignity from the Good News.

Kathy Galloway from the Iona Community has praised the Risen Christ with these words.

Christ our life, you are alive
in the beauty of the earth
in the rhythm of the seasons
in the mystery of time and space
Alleluia

Christ our life, you are alive
in the tenderness of touch
in the heartbeat of intimacy
in the insights of solitude
Alleluia

Christ our life, you are alive
in the creative possibility
of the dullest conversation
the dreariest task
the most threatening event
Alleluia

Christ our life, you are alive
to offer re-creation
to every unhealed hurt
to every deadened place
to every damaged heart
Alleluia

You set before us a great choice.
Therefore we choose life.
The dance of resurrection soars and surges
through the whole creation.
