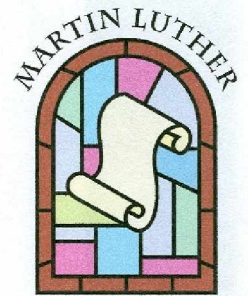

Devotion on the Verse of the Month for April

Dear Congregation,

Do you think that faith can wear out? That faith grows “old”, useless? What a strange question, you may perhaps think, because faith is indeed not like a bag of milk which must be consumed by a certain date so that it does not spoil. Still, I dare use the idea in this devotion

now that many of us encounter the problem in their daily life that enthusiasm quickly passes and the question remains, what faith truly achieves. Even after special festivities, it does not take long before the “Aroma” of God’s love has evaporated. However, at Easter it is clearly put before our eyes, that God goes even through death for us and gives us the hope through eternal life that once and for all everything is well, not just for the moment, but forever and ever. God’s love has no “to be used before” date, it does not turn bad. God’s love shall be food for us, a “means to live”, from which we can cut a thick slice every day, without the danger that the supply runs out. – In our

verse for the month, the whole even world is taken into view, not only we, not only our church, not only this city, this country, no, the whole world is reconciled with God, can experience that God comes close to it, forgives, gives hope. This is truly a great message which simply puts before us the grand possibilities God has for us. Why does

this thought not keep for long in every day life? The answer lies herein that we are very quickly preoccupied with ourselves only. Our life often

seems to us as a one-way street, where there is no way out and where we are all alone on the road. But many Easter stories, as the one about the disciples on their

way to Emmaus, are about the fact that the risen Jesus Christ is with those who “labour hard and are heavy laden”. What does Christ say at the very end of the Gospel of Matthew: “*Lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age.*” (Matthew 28, 20) Recently, I have met a couple, who, after many happy and carefree years, experience a serious

illness entering their daily life. A complicated, lengthy operation and an uncertain future burden these two people now; they only have each other, no children, no close relatives. I called and had a long telephone conversation with the wife. I quickly realized that, because there is not other topic at the moment

but cancer – which is understandable - any message from God, no matter how good it may be, is not at all in focus any longer. I have explained to the woman: “I know how you feel. You think that you have to get through this all by yourself. But I want to tell you: You are not alone! Others think of you and pray for you. I believe that you



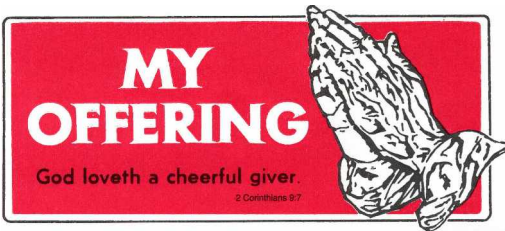

have to be told this right now, because you by yourself will probably not realize this any more.” – She agreed with me. And somehow, we all are in the same situation. Particularly good things pale very quickly before the things that determine daily life. We need reminders of the communion with God, his love for us and of the community other people share with us. Easter, too, our most important feast is not a story from long ago. It is

God’s message to us. The message that God loves us and that he is with us, no matter where our road in life leads us. A message that does not grow old and that never wears out.

EASTER SUNRISE SERVICE

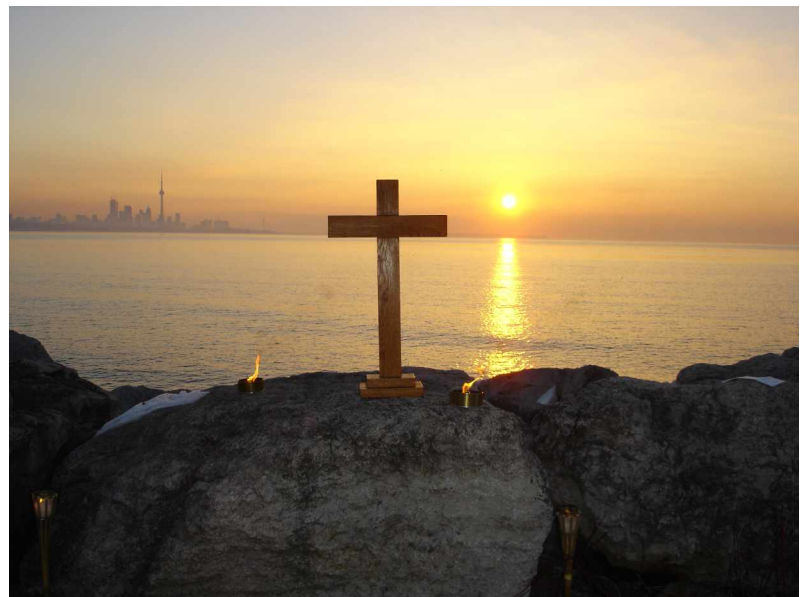
April 16th, 5:30 a.m.

- 8:30** Easter Egg Hunt, games and crafts for children
