

#### **DEVOTION**

Dear Fellow Christians in the Martin Luther Church,

In Canada and Germany, October is the month of Thanksgiving (whereas in the USA Thanksgiving at the end of November marks the beginning of

the Christmas Season). In our MLC, we love to gather for this celebration and express our gratefulness before God from whom we do receive so many blessings during this year.

There is a good old story about gratitude and thankfulness: There was a mediaeval king who regularly used the advice of a wise man. This sage was summoned to the king's presence. The monarch asked him how to get rid of his anxiety and depression of spirits, how he might be really happy, for he was sick in body and mind. The sage replied, "There is but one cure for the king. Your Majesty must

sleep one night in the shirt of a happy man." Messengers were dispatched throughout the realm to search for a man who was truly happy. But everyone who was approached had some cause for misery, something that robbed them of true and complete happiness. At last they found a man – a poor beggar – who sat smiling by the roadside and, when they asked him if he was really happy

and had no sorrows, he confessed that he was a truly happy man. Then they told him what they wanted. The king must sleep one night in the shirt of a happy man, and had given them a large sum of money to procure such a shirt. Would he sell them his shirt that the king might wear it? The beggar burst into uncontrollable laughter, and rep-

lied, "I am sorry I cannot oblige the king. I haven't a shirt on my back."

When we compare our journey of life with this beggar's life, immediately we become aware of the abundance of good things we have been given and entrusted. However, so often we don't care about this, so often we completely forget to thank God for this in prayer.

"Gratitude changes the pangs of memory into a tranquil joy", wrote Dietrich Bonhoeffer. Thanking God, this strengthens our heart and changes our daily

life. "Give thanks in all circumstances", this is Paul's advice in 1 Thessalonians 5:18.

Our celebration of Thanksgiving provides an excellent opportunity to start practicing this again.
